Minutes of June 28, 2010

Meeting was called to order by Social Justice Chair Karen Krause at 5:35 PM at the Collingwood Arts Center. 7 others were in attendance representing 7 member organizations.

Minutes: Minutes of May 24th were read and approved.

Treasurer's Report: The balance as of May 31st was \$21,610.02

Committee Reports:

1. Healthcare:

- a. **UHCAN Ohio-** Think before you Ink! Was a success. The opposition will continue to collect signatures.
- b. **HCAN** – A group called the “Young Invincibles” will be blitzing soon with the expansion of Healthcare to 26 years old.
- c. **NWO/UHCAN** – Meetings made need to change or move. It will be discussed in the future.

2. **JwJ** –The USSF took place in Detroit June 22-26. There was a gathering on Tuesday of travelers to the USSF sponsored by JwJ and FLOC. We received decent news coverage. Karen and Bob attended on Wednesday. The event was well attended and made for some interesting protests and learning experiences.

- a. Discussion started about a possible social event to just kick back and enjoy the friends in the movement.
- b. Calls to Capitol Hill need to continue for Financial Reform.
- c. Possible Rally in front of Senator Voinovich’s office to protest the filibuster of unemployment extensions.

3. IWJ –

- a. IWJ National Conference will take place June 18-21, 2011 in Chicago. Plans to attend are being discussed.
- b. Labor in the Pulpit is right around the corner. We need to continue to reach out to congregations to expand the program.
- c. City Council hearings will take place on immigration and racial profiling on July 6th at 1 PM.

4. **UFCW** – The NLRB election for Wolfcreek Nursing Home on June 4th was won by UFCW and the Avalon Nursing Home election on June 11th was won also.

5. **Community Shares** – Fundraiser August 25th Hot August nights. Tickets are \$35 a piece and available. Community Shares continues to look for items to be donated for the silent auction part of the event.

6. **Sunoco** – The final outcome of the campaign seems to indicate that thanks to Jobs with Justice’s involvement and connections although it wasn’t total victory immediately but will be going forward.
