Minutes of November 22, 2010

Minutes: Minutes of October 25th were read and approved.

Treasurer's Report: The balance as of October 31st was \$27,986.22.

1. Healthcare:

A motion to endorse the One Ohio Now Campaign was made by Bob Glover, seconded by Nancy Ellis and passed.

8. **ONE Bowling Green** – Both issues won at the polls on Election Day.
